

# New world record by kiwi pilot



**ASH 25** was a German-made craft with a 26.5m wingspan

**They travelled over 2,500km, at an average of 160kph. up and down both islands, during the 15 hour flight.**

**The flight started from Omarama at 5.20am, then flew to Ward, in Marlborough, then back down to Clyde in Otago.**

**Sunday 3.44pm**

The flight took them North, inland from Hastings.

**At Clyde they turned north and glided the length of the South Island, across Cook Strait, and turned back at Napier, reaching Omarama just before 9pm.**

**Sunday 9.00pm**

**Landed back at Omarama airfield**

**Sunday 12.04pm**

The flight took them as far south as Clyde, between Cromwell and Alexandra.
